potato salad, deviled eggs to take back to their rigs. But this was a hardy group. We hung out in the drizzle enjoying the cool, damp TX




weather and all our friends. Ending with Root Beer Floats!

In preparation for our rally on the Texas A&M campus in College Station, please be advised of the following:

Call Transportation Services Department at Texas A&M

make your own parking reservation after August 1st.

- The phone # is **979-862-2551**. You will need to have your credit card information ready. They will mail you your permits that are to be displayed in the window of your RV and your tow/towed vehicle while parked on campus.
- In addition to your credit card information, please have your <u>RV license plate #</u> and <u>Auto license plate #</u> ready when making your reservation. This is their way of letting the campus police know that you are parked legally.
- Request parking on the <u>Olsen lot</u>. The parking fee is \$40 a night. All sites have 30/50 amp service, and water.
- · There is a dump station located in this lot.
- · It is advised that you **call early** to give the department time to mail your permits.
- If you call the week of the rally there will not be enough time to mail the permits.
- Parking spaces have a painted number in the center of your RV space.
- Please try and make all reservations before September 21st.
- · If you want to arrive on Thursday the 27th that is OK.



DOB, DOB - You're Endangered

Find any dobs of mud around your rig lately? Beware of the wasp-like bugs hovering around your RV as they may have plans to disrupt your peace of mind. As I was readying my rig to head for Livingston last week, I began to check my motorhome that had been sitting idle since the April Region Rally in Abilene.
